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Background

Financial & Corporate Relations (FCR), part of SPRG, launched its inaugural Australian Precious Metals Day to connect ASX-listed mining companies with Asian investors in Hong Kong.

The initiative was driven by a strong precious metals market backdrop, with gold and silver prices rising significantly, alongside the solid performance of newly listed resource companies in Hong Kong. At the same time, while HKEX has limited representation of junior mining companies, there is clear underlying investor interest in the space, though investors in the region rarely look proactively at the ASX junior sector.

The event was designed to bring a curated group of Australian precious metals companies directly to Hong Kong investors, providing an opportunity to better understand the sector and engage with companies across the development spectrum.

What We Did?

- Designed a focused investor engagement format tailored for Hong Kong investors
- Opened with Blue Ocean analyst session to educate investors on evaluating junior mining companies
- Curated 4 ASX-listed companies across producer, developer and explorer stages
- Kept format small and selective to enable deeper, more meaningful discussions
- Secured support from Blue Ocean and Macquarie Bank to enhance credibility and investor reach

Outcome

- 60+ investors attended, including institutional funds, family offices and dedicated metals investors
- Strong interest in ASX precious metals opportunities across producers, developers and explorers
- Investors valued the focused format, allowing deeper understanding vs large-scale conferences
- Positive feedback that the event provided direct access to quality companies not typically available in Hong Kong
- Participating companies secured multiple follow-up meetings and calls post-event
